

What to Know About Cryptocurrency and Scams

Cryptocurrency is a type of digital currency that generally exists only electronically and is stored in a digital wallet. You can buy cryptocurrency (e.g., Bitcoin) through an exchange, an app, a website, or a cryptocurrency ATM. Cryptocurrency accounts are not government insured and the values change constantly.

Crypto-investment frauds have continued to grow significantly resulting in losses of approximately \$3.3 billion in 2022. Scammers are always finding new ways to steal your money using cryptocurrency. To steer clear of a crypto con, here are some things to know:

- Only scammers demand payment in cryptocurrency
- Only scammers will guarantee profits or big returns
- Never mix online dating and investment advice
- Avoid anything that seems too good to be true Crypto scams to watch out for:
 - Blackmail and extortion scams •
 - Giveaway Scams
 - Impersonation scams
 - Investment scams
 - "Business Opportunity" scams Phishing scams
- Romance scams
- Fake job listing scams
- Giveaway scams
- Tech Support scams

It is important to spot the signs of a crypto scam early so that it can be avoided. Once you have fallen for a scammer's trap, it is virtually impossible to get your money back.
